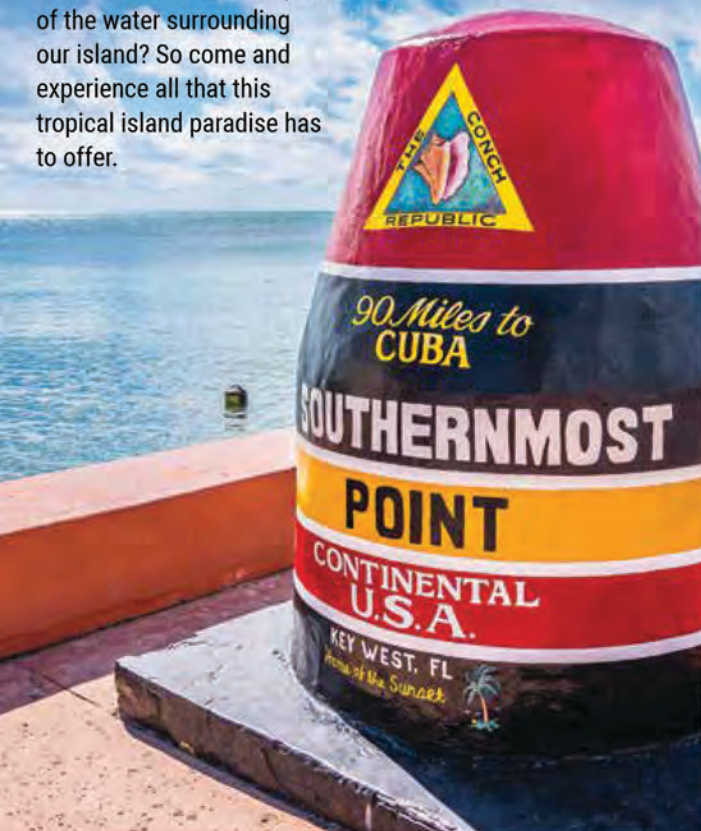

# THE ROAD TO KEY WEST

The road to Key West is a popular "bucket list" journey for many visitors to the Florida Keys. People often ask the question of whether they should fly or drive. The road down the Keys was originally blazed in 1912 by millionaire Henry Flagler, who built the Overseas Railroad from Miami to Key West. This journey incorporates an astonishing 113 miles of roadway with 42 bridges, including the famous 7-mile bridge (which is actually 6.79 miles long), spanning over the open waters of the Atlantic Ocean, Florida Bay and the Gulf of Mexico. As you move from island to island, you'll witness breathtaking water views, making the drive an adventure.

Now that you're on island time, we encourage you to plan ahead and visit our sister islands. It's not uncommon for the non-stop trip from Miami to Key West to take several hours, so give yourself ample time if you need to catch a flight, especially on weekends. Heavy congestion can cause major slow downs and road closures, so it's always best to be prepared.

The Keys are broken down into three areas which include the Lower Keys and Key West, Middle Keys which include its biggest island Marathon, and the Upper Keys. While driving, pay attention to the green mile markers on the side of the road, they are critical to finding restaurants, resorts and shops along the way.
